Wayne State Head Volleyball Coach

Scott Kneifl has elevated the Wildcat program to a new level in his five seasons as head coach, directing Wayne State College to a 131-48 overall record and a 66-24 mark in the Northern Sun Conference. The Wildcats have qualified for the NCAA National Tournament the last five seasons and added the school's first-ever NSIC Tournament title in 2007.



Kneifl coached the Wildcats to a 29-8 record in 2009, going 16-4 in the Northern Sun Conference to finish in second place. The Wildcats won a school record 15 consecutive matches from Aug. 29-Sept. 25 to highlight a season where WSC qualified for the NCAA Division II Tournament for the fifth straight season. Kneifl was rewarded for his teams' success by being named the 2009 NSIC Coach of the Year, marking the second time in five years that he has received the NSIC Coach of the Year honor (2005).

WSC finished the 2009 season ranked 18th in the final AVCA Division II Top 25 Coaches Poll, marking the highest ever national ranking for a Wildcat volleyball team to end the season.

WSC Assistant Volleyball Coach Kim Edwards

Kim Edwards enters her third season as an assistant coach with the Wayne State College volleyball program. The Sioux City (Iowa) Heelan High School graduate coaches the setters for the Wildcats while also handling recruiting duties and camp coordinator responsibilities. Before coming to WSC, Edwards served two seasons as a graduate assistant coach at Emporia State in Kansas where she was a standout setter. She was a First Team All-MIAA selection as a senior, recording a league-best 1,489 assists.
