### Camp Director • Scott Kneifl Wayne State Head Volleyball Coach

Scott Kneifl has served nine seasons as head volleyball coach at Wayne State College, guiding the Wildcats to an impressive 224-80 record (.737) during that time, including a 125-45 mark in Northern Sun Conference games. He became the school's all-time wins leader on October 12, 2013 with his 215th career win, a 3-0 sweep over Minnesota State.

Kneifl coached the Wildcats to a 22-10 record in the 2013 season, finishing sixth in the NSIC with a 12-8 league mark. Wayne State finished the 2013 season ranked 21st in the final AVCA Division II

Top 25 Coaches Poll, marking the fifth straight year and seven of the last nine years that the Wildcats have ended the season ranked in the Top 25.

Kneiff has led Wayne State College to eight NCAA Division II National Tournament appearances while coaching four All-Americans (Emily Schroeder in 2006 and '07 and Jennifer Hefner in 2009 and '10). He is a two-time NSIC Coach of the Year (2005, 2009) and has led the Wildcats to nine straight 20+win seasons.

### WSC Assistant Coach Kim DePew (Edwards)

Kim DePew (Edwards) enters her seventh season as an assistant coach with the Wayne State College volleyball program. The Sioux City (Iowa) Heelan High School graduate coaches the setters for the Wildcats while also handling recruiting duties and camp coordinator responsibilities. Before coming to WSC, DePew (Edwards) served two seasons as a graduate assistant coach at Emporia State in Kansas where she was a standout setter. She was a First Team All-MIAA selection



as a senior, recording a league-best 1,489 assists.

#### **WSC Graduate Assistant Coach Korie Lebeda**

Korie Lebeda is in her second season as graduate assistant coach at Wayne State College. Lebeda played volleyball at Creighton from 2005-08 where she started all 119 matches of her career and was named All-Missouri Valley Conference three times. She currently ranks as the career leader in assists at Creighton with 5,281 and is seventh in career digs with 1,130. Lebeda played one season of professional volleyball in Spain and served four years as an assistant volleyball coach



at Papillion-LaVista High School while also working at the Volleyball Academy in Omaha for approximately two years.
