Camp Director • Scott Kneifl Wayne State Head Volleyball Coach

Scott Kneifl has served 10 seasons as head volleyball coach at Wayne State College, guiding the Wildcats to an impressive 251-87 record (.743) during that time, including a 141-49 mark in Northern Sun Conference games. He became the school's all-time wins leader on October 12, 2013 with his 215th career win, a 3-0 sweep over Minnesota State.



Kneifl coached the Wildcats to a 27-7 record in the 2014 season,

finishing third in the NSIC with a 16-4 league mark. Wayne State advanced to the NSIC Tournament title match in 2014 and reached the NCAA Division II National Tournament for the ninth time in 10 years and beat Central Missouri in the first round. The Wildcats finished 2014 ranked sixth in the final AVCA Division II Top 25 Coaches Poll, the highest-ever national ranking to end the season and sixth straight year that the Wildcats ended the year ranked in the Top 25.

Kneifl has led Wayne State College to nine NCAA Division II National Tournament appearances in his 10 seasons with the Wildcats while coaching four All-Americans (Emily Schroeder in 2006 and '07 and Jennifer Hefner in 2009 and '10). He is a two-time NSIC Coach of the Year (2005, 2009) and has led the Wildcats to 10 straight 20+ win seasons.

WSC Assistant Coach Kim DePew

Kim DePew (Edwards) enters her eighth season as an assistant coach with the Wayne State College volleyball program. The Sioux City (Iowa) Heelan High School graduate coaches the setters for the Wildcats while also handling recruiting duties and camp coordinator responsibilities. Before coming to WSC, DePew (Edwards) served two seasons as a graduate assis-



tant coach at Emporia State in Kansas where she was a standout setter. She was a First Team All-MIAA selection as a senior, recording a league-best 1,489 assists.
