## Camp Director • Scott Kneifl Wayne State Head Volleyball Coach

Scott Kneifl has coached the Wayne State College volleyball team for the last 11 seasons, guiding the Wildcats to an impressive 279-95 record (.746) during that time including a 157-53 mark in Northern Sun Conference games.

Kneifl coached the Wildcats to a 28-8 record in the 2015 season, capped by the schools' first-ever NCAA Central Region title and Elite Eight appearance. The Wildcats defeated



#8 Central Missouri (3-1), #4 Southwest Minnesota State (3-1) and #1 Concordia-St. Paul (3-0) to win the Central Region title, then advanced to the NCAA Division II National Championships in Tampa, Florida where WSC defeated Carson-Newman (Tenn.) 3-1 before falling in a hard-fought match to Palm Beach Atlantic in the National Semi-Finals. Wayne State ended the year ranked third in the final AVCA Division II Top 25 Coaches' Poll, the highest-ever national ranking for a Wayne State athletic team.

Kneifl has led Wayne State College to 10 NCAA Division II National Tournament appearances in his 11 years with the Wildcats while coaching five All-Americans (Emily Schroeder in 2006 and '07, Jennifer Hefner in 2009 and '10 and Alyssa Frauendorfer in 2015). He is a two-time NSIC Coach of the Year (2005, 2009) and has led the Wildcats to 11 straight 20+ win seasons.

#### WSC Assistant Coach Kim DePew

Kim DePew (Edwards) enters her ninth season as an assistant coach with the Wayne State College volleyball program. The Sioux City (Iowa) Heelan High School graduate coaches the setters for the Wildcats while also handling recruiting duties and camp coordinator responsibilities. Before coming to WSC, DePew (Edwards) served two seasons as a graduate assistant coach at Emporia State in Kansas where she was a



standout setter. She was a First Team All-MIAA selection as a senior, recording a league-best 1,489 assists.
