I do hereby release the Board of Trustees of the Nebraska State Colleges, Wayne State College, the WSC Athletic Camp and all its trustees, officers, administrators, agents, employees and camp personnel from all liability, including claims or suits in law or equity related to any bodily injury (including but not limited to) loss of life, accident, or loss (personal property or other). Furthermore, I realize the risks involved as a camp participant and I understand that I am responsible to pay, or otherwise cover through my insurance, any medical or hospital expenses, doctor bills or other expenses which could be incurred as a result of treatment given for illness or injury, incurred while attending or subsequent to attending the WSC Athletic Camp. I hereby authorize the staff of Wayne State College and the WSC Athletic Camp to act for me according to their best judgment in any emergency requiring medical attention. I understand if my child presents concussion-like symptoms during an evaluation from a Certified Athletic Trainer at a WSC Athletic Camp, he/she will no longer be allowed to participate at camp. As a parent/guardian I must make arrangements to remove my child from camp as soon as I have been notified of my child's condition. I further give my permission for Wayne State College and the WSC Athletic Camp to use, for publicity or advertising purposes, any photographs taken of me at the camp.

State Vehicle Waiver

I, _____ (Camper's Name) have requested that I be allowed to ride in the State vehicle provided by the Wayne State College Athletic (Department). It has been explained that if we are in an accident while I am a passenger in the vehicle owned by the State of Nebraska, I am not covered for medical expenses or other damages. I accept that as a condition of my being provided transportation, I waive any right I might have to claim any amount for damages I might suffer, including but not limited to, medical expenses and pain and suffering, if the motor vehicle I'm riding in is involved in an accident and I am injured. I specifically agree not to file a complaint against the State for the above type of injuries and damages. I understand that if there is an accident, which is caused by someone other than by the State driver/vehicle, that this does not affect my ability to sue the party driving or owning the other vehicle.

It has been explained that I am required to wear my seat belt at all times in this vehicle, I am not allowed to smoke in this vehicle, and I must comply with all rules governing state employee use of this vehicle. I know that I do not have the approval to drive this vehicle unless it is considered an immediate emergency. In case of such emergency, the state's liability insurance will remain in effect.

Camp Director • Scott Kneifl Wayne State Head Volleyball Coach

Scott Kneifl has coached the Wayne State College volleyball team for the last 14 seasons, guiding the Wildcats to an impressive 344-124 record (.735) during that time including a 196-74 mark in Northern Sun Conference games.

Kneifl coached the Wildcats to a 22-9 record in 2018, including a 13-7 mark in the rugged Northern Sun Conference. WSC led the NSIC in blocks per set (2.56), which tied for sixth in NCAA Division II, and led the NSIC in opponent attack percentage (.151).

Under Kneifl in 2015, the Wildcats made school history by winning the NCAA Central Regional and advancing to the Elite Eight for the first time. WSC beat Carson-Newman (Tenn.) in the national quarterfinals before falling to Palm Beach Atlantic in the Final Four, ending the season with a 28-8 record. The Wildcats were third in the final AVCA Division II Top 25 Coaches Poll.

Kneifl has led Wayne State College to 11 NCAA Division II National Tournament appearances in his 14 years with the Wildcats while coaching five All-Americans (Emily Schroeder in 2006 and '07, Jennifer Hefner in 2009 and '10 and Alyssa Frauendorfer in 2015). He is a two-time NSIC Coach of the Year (2005, 2009) and has led the Wildcats to 13 20+ win seasons in his 14 years as head coach.



WSC Assistant Coach Kim DePew

Kim DePew (Edwards)

enters her 11th year as an assistant coach with the Wayne State College volleyball program. The Sioux City (Iowa) Heelan High School graduate coaches the setters for the Wildcats while also handling recruiting duties and camp coordinator responsibilities. Before coming to WSC, DePew (Edwards) served two seasons as a graduate assistant coach at Emporia State in Kansas where she was a standout setter. She was a First Team All-MIAA selection as a senior, recording a league-best 1,489 assists.



WSC Coaching Assistant Katie Morris

Katie Morris is in her third year as a Volleyball Coaching Assistant at Wayne State College. A former Wildcat volleyball standout, Katie (Hughes) Morris is one of just seven players in school history to record 1,000 kills and 1,000 digs during her playing career from 2012-15. She currently ranks third in career digs (1,924) and 15th in career kills (1,177).

Morris was a First Team All-NSIC selection as a senior in 2015, recording 20 double-doubles while averaging 3.57 kills and 4.74 digs per set. She helped the Wildcats to a 28-8 record as a senior, winning the schools' first-ever NCAA Central Region title and trip to the NCAA Division II national semi-finals. Morris was a four-year starter during her Wildcat career.
