Camp Director • Scott Kneifl
Wayne State Head Volleyball Coach

In six seasons as head coach, Scott Kneifl has led the Wildcat volleyball program to six NCAA Division II national tournament appearances. He has coached WSC to a 157-52 mark, going 83-27 in Northern Sun Conference play in his six seasons as leader of the Wildcats.

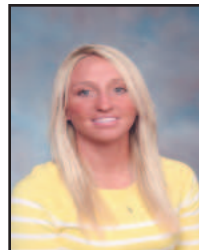
Kneifl coached the Wildcats to a 26-4 record in the 2010 season, going 17-3 in the Northern Sun Conference to finish in third place. WSC set a new school record with 16 straight wins to open the season while also earning the school's first-ever #1 national ranking twice during the 2010 season.

WSC finished the 2010 season ranked ninth in the final AVCA Division II Top 25 Coaches Poll, marking the highest ever national ranking for a Wildcat volleyball team to end the season. The Wildcat program has also become one of the most watched volleyball teams in NCAA Division II as the Wildcats ranked seventh in home attendance in 2009 and fifth in 2010 with a new school record average of 757 fans per home contest at Rice Auditorium.



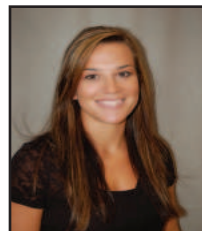
WSC Assistant Volleyball Coach Kim Edwards

Kim Edwards enters her fourth season as an assistant coach with the Wayne State College volleyball program. The Sioux City (Iowa) Heelan High School graduate coaches the setters for the Wildcats while also handling recruiting duties and camp coordinator responsibilities. Before coming to WSC, Edwards served two seasons as a graduate assistant coach at Emporia State in Kansas where she was a standout setter. She was a First Team All-MIAA selection as a senior, recording a league-best 1,489 assists.



WSC Graduate Assistant Coach Amanda Nelson

Amanda Nelson is in her first season as a graduate assistant coach with the Wayne State College volleyball program. Nelson, a 2006 graduate of Wakefield High School, attended Central Community College in Columbus, Nebraska for two years where she received her Associate Degree and received All-American honors as a starter with the Raiders. Nelson then transferred to Morningside College in Sioux City, Iowa and played libero for the Mustang volleyball team. She earned her bachelor's degree in business Administration from Morningside in December, 2010.
